

Advanced Neurology and Neurosurgery Coding Course

Prerequisites: Completion of a professional coding course, or 1 year of Professional Fee coding experience recommended.

Clock Hours: 10 hours

Training Description:

This online course is designed for coding professionals working in Neurology and Neurosurgery. Students will learn anatomy of the nervous system, diagnostic conditions associated with the nervous system, and procedures performed on the neurological system and how to code them. This advanced certificate course includes advanced CPT, HCPCS Level II, and ICD-10-CM coding for diagnostic and surgical neurology services. Complex cases are included and dissected in the reading material and lectures to show practical application.

Training Objectives:

- 1. Master anatomical concepts important to understand the nervous system.
- 2. Review terminology relevant to the nervous system.
- 3. Provide practical advice to overcome the most common CPT® coding dilemmas involving the nervous system.
- 4. Alert you to important documentation issues and possible shortcomings, as they apply to procedures of the nervous system.
- 5. Discuss application of most-frequently used CPT[®] modifiers.
- 6. Introduce ICD-10-CM and HCPCS Level II codes and coding guidelines as they apply to the nervous system.
- 7. Supply hands-on examples and review material to improve your mastery of the above concepts.

Training Content:
